

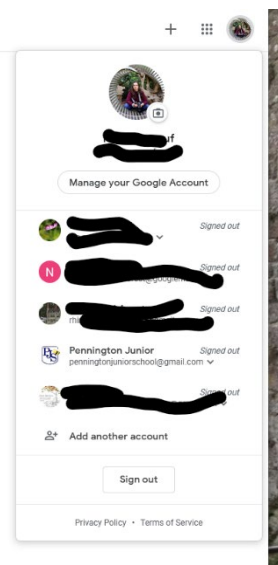
Frequently Asked Questions Re Google Classrooms for Pennington Junior School Students and Parents

1. I have more than one child, how do I log in with another child?

On a computer, with child A logged in. Click on the Google Icon that identifies that child – top right hand corner. You then get a drop down list which looks a little like this (accounts will be different).

Go to the bottom option and click Add another account – add child B – you can then switch between the accounts on the same device.

On Andriod devices, it is a similar process – but the circle identifying the user logged in is 2nd from right along the top – you are looking for the circle which is next to the three dots.



2. I am using a chrome Browser – can you advise.

You follow the link to Google classroom - https://edu.google.com/intl/en_uk/products/classroom/ whilst log in as a current google user.

You then clicked on the google icon top right hand corner - see image – first clicking on the icon we labelled 1 and then clicking add new account.

Add another account with the Email:

FirstNameInitialofSurname@penningtonJunior.co.uk for example Mike Smith would be mikes@penningtonJunior.co.uk - click next – you then need to input the password which is child's first name all lower case and then their date of birth – so for Mike Smith born on the 25th May 2010 it would be mike250510

You can then click on the box and choose to join as a student.

3. My child's google account is not the one you have told me to use?

Every child at Pennington Junior's has a google account using their school email address – it is an educational email, and as they move through the education system their email this will change – each school has its own and it is for education use only.

At Pennington Junior school it has been created in a generic format with every child's password following the same format. This enables us to get all the children online in their online classrooms quickly, to assist in their learning at school and at home.

We request that you do not not change your child's password or try a different as we want to be able to easily identify and help each child and keep each classroom safe.

4. I want to learn more about Google Classrooms to help my child

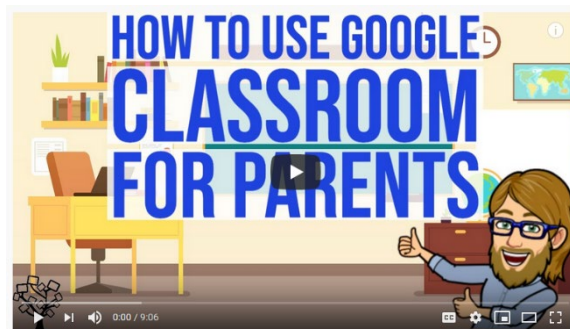
The 'stream' which is the front page, is where teachers' direct children to learning links and websites and would be the best place for children to explore when they first access their classroom.

On the 'classwork' tab, there may also be assignments, quizzes or questions that are set. Clear instructions will be written to explain how to complete each task. Children don't need to save anything anywhere as Google automatically saves their work as they go in a folder that their teacher can see.

If there is an issue, children can send a private message to their teacher asking for help.
