In the final week of term, children will enjoy a day of exciting activities as a reward for their hard work.

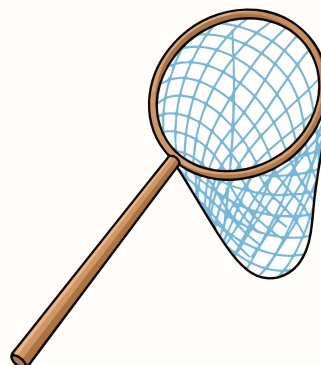
### 🌱 Growing and Exploring Nature

# Learning Across the School



## Year R

Year R will be exploring the theme of travel and holidays, with a particular focus on Africa. They will be learning about African animals and fruits and comparing these to those found in our local New Forest, and are very excited about their upcoming visit to Minstead to explore the plants and wildlife firsthand.

## Year 1 & Year 2

Year 1 and Year 2 will be learning about Mary Anning, including a guided fossil hunt at Highcliffe Beach and a workshop at St Barbe's Museum. They will also be continuing their work on plants, growing their own fruit, vegetables and flowers.

## Year 3

Year 3 will be continuing their study of smuggling in the New Forest, including a workshop at St Barbe's Museum and a geography field trip to the sea wall. During this visit, they will explore why the coast was ideal for smuggling and discover the local flora and fauna.

## Year 4

Year 4 will be exploring the Ancient Egyptians, including the pyramids and beliefs around mummification. In Science, they will focus on plant growth and will be creating their own garden in the school grounds.

## Year 5

In English, Year 5 will be studying the exciting story Treasure Island. They will also be learning about Ancient Greece and its lasting impact on modern life. In Science, their focus will be Space.

## Year 6

Year 6 will be continuing their study of the Ancient Islamic Empire, exploring its importance as an innovative and influential civilisation. In Science, they will be learning about reproduction in animals and humans.

## PSHE

This half term, we will be learning about Relationships and Health Education through our Jigsaw programme. We will also be offering information sessions for parents to explain the content of the lessons and provide an opportunity to ask any questions.

**Time: 4.30pm - 5.30pm**

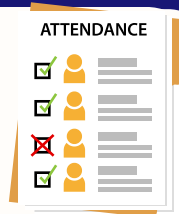
This meeting will provide an opportunity to meet the Reception team, learn more about the school day and routines, and ask any questions.

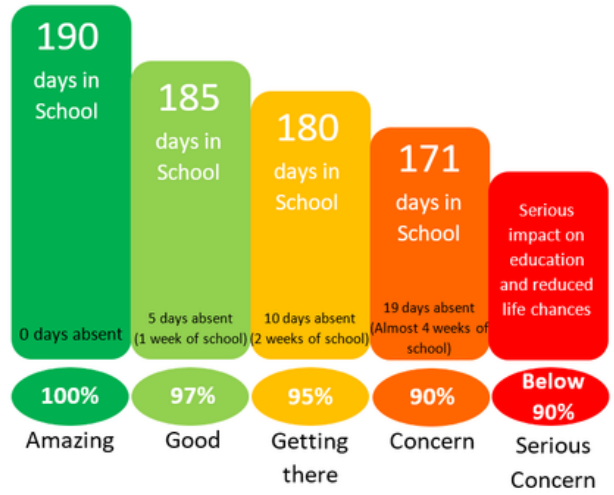
